Waste Electrical and Electronics Equipment Regulations

As a producer and supplier to the Business to Business electronics market, we are committed to the protection of the environment and therefore the successful implementation of the Waste Electrical and Electronics Equipment Regulations 2006 (WEEE).

Our WEEE policy number is WEE/BD3410VZ. We are a registered producer of WEEE and a member of an approved compliance scheme operated by Veolia Environmental Services (UK) PLC.

It is our policy to offer a like for like, one for one exchange service to customers wishing to purchase new hardware. The take back of old hardware in exchange for new extends to hardware placed on the market before 13th August 2005. Customers wishing to replace WEEE items should advise Impulse at the time of placing their order for new equipment. Under the WEEE regulations, all new WEEE compliant goods should now be marked with the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol shown in the box on to the right. As a company, we strive to:

- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations and requirements
- Recycle all waste material possible
- Reduce the amount of waste material produced

- Make use of car sharing where car travel is unavoidable
- Avoid unnecessary travel by making use of instant messaging, video and audio conferencing, telephone and email
